Dear Students,

To successfully complete this project, you will first need to create a survey about what life will be like 100 years in the future called The Future Survey. Once you have created your survey, you will ask the questions on your survey to 10 people.

RESEARCH / PREPARATORY WORK

- Come up with 10 questions to ask in a survey and write it down on the **Future Survey Questionnaire**.
- Ask the 10 survey questions to 10 people and record their answers on the **Future Survey Questionnaire**.
- Include a title in your report with the name of the project, your name, your class, and the date.
- Write 5 paragraphs (40-50 sentences) for your survey report.
- Include the 10 survey questions with the answers in *my 5-paragraph survey report*.
- Use singular/plural verbs and quantity expressions/words.
- Check for spelling, punctuation and grammar errors.
- Create at least 3 charts/graphs for your survey report
- Use Canva to create your Future Survey Report



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. You will come up with 10 questions to ask in your survey. The questions must be a YES or NO question. Write your question on the Future Survey Questionnaire Template.
2. You will ask the survey questions to 10 people. They can be your classmates, teachers, parents, or other students. Record their answers on your Future Survey Questionnaire.
3. You will write a survey report with the results using CANVA. Use the data/answers from your Future Survey Questionnaire and write a 5-paragraph (40-50 sentences) survey report.
4. You must choose at-least 3 questions from your survey to include graphs or charts in your FINAL survey report.

-You must organize your survey report as shown below and include the following:

Title: Project title, your name, class, date

Paragraph 1: Introduction – Introduce the topic and the purpose of your report

Paragraph 2: Body – Results of questions 1-3, graph or chart

Paragraph 3: Body – Results of questions 4-7, graph or chart

Paragraph 4: Body – Results of questions 8-10, graph or chart

Paragraph 3: Conclusion – Conclusion/closing for your report

-Your report must include these:

- You must use singular and plural verbs (e.g. *travels/travel, lives/live*)
- You must use quantity expressions/words (e.g. *nobody, everybody, some, most, more than half, one or two people, half*)
- You must check for spelling, punctuation, and grammar errors
